Asset Transfer Update a.

> The IW Council was given details of the new site plan on 5/12/12 together with the explanatory notes in the hope that this would make things easier for them in their negotiations with the Dept of Education. A request more recently made for an update on

marketing of the site has, so far, been ignored.

b. Site Plan

> A new plan was produced prior to Christmas, which involved moving the allotments to the orchard site and increasing the "sporting & physical activity" profile of the planned use of the main playing field site, to reflect concerns received from the IW Council about their negotiations with the Dept for Education. The committee members who responded supported the revised scheme and it was

Resolved: To approve the new site plan.
