A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

I met an old family friend a while ago and taking my face, the dear elderly lady said, 'You haven't changed a bit.' Now she is a wonderful person but sadly as I look in the mirror, I see that she is very much mistaken....in oh so many ways! Last time she saw me my hair was much longer (and less grey), I was a lot thinner, in my teens I loved Wham and was rarely seen without wearing Doc Martens, I spent my free time swimming, dancing....and reading! Aha, perhaps there is something that has remained with me since my childhood!

I have always loved reading. My Mum used to continually tell me to 'put down the book' so I can walk down the stairs, come to the table to eat, get ready for school.... you know live a normal life! However, the tables have now turned and I am sure she is inwardly laughing every time she hears me saying the same words to my eldest who is a complete bookworm and now even to the younger one who has not been able to put down a series of books over the summer! But ladies and gentlemen, do not think I am complaining, definitely not! I started reading to my boys whilst they were still in my womb and it is certainly one of my greatest joys when they now read stories to me!

Frederick Douglass once said, 'Once you learn to read, you will be forever free.' And I have the pleasure of sharing that freedom and joy with some amazing women in a Book Club that I have the privilege to be part of. We have enjoyed reading a variety of diverse books over the past few months, fiction and non-fiction, and discussing them which always gives me a different insight to the one I had. Stimulating and challenging for my old brain cells but the best thing I get out of these get togethers is just being with dear friends.

What is it that I love so much? Down time from work? Being with fun people? Yes of course those are two big reasons, but you get so much more than that when you are with people who care about you. And as a Christian I have one of the best books to hand in the Bible, where God continually gives His followers encouragement, confidence, strength and love, and that includes us reading it today.

So why not pick up a book this month and submerge yourself again in stories of adventure, of mystery, of love, of joy — whatever is your favourite genre. Submerge yourself in another time and place and have some fun doing it. And hopefully you will return to the younger version of yourself with a larger dose of confidence and motivation so you can go and do something which you thought you would never do! Live out your potential — for your sake and I am sure your family, friends and perhaps even our community will benefit too: never has there been a time when we have needed more heroes in our society!

Cowes Traffic Order.

This has been modified, approved and processed by the IW Council, with the new order being put in place in the coming weeks. This will be monitored and further action may be considered, should parking issues not be resolved.

Cowes Week Parking.

Overnight parked vehicles, mobile homes, obstructed driveways, removed traffic cones, lack of enforcement, disabled access concerns, ambiguity of signage and a parked digger obstructing traffic kept me busy this Cowes Week. In response, a meeting with Highways Officers and Officers overseeing the event is being arranged to address lessons learnt. From feedback received a restriction for overnight parking on Princes and Egypt Esplanade during the event remains a priority. I am hopeful this meeting can take next month. If you have not already contacted me and have views, please let me know before 10th October. Parking Officers advised that 418 parking contravention notices were issued during Cowes Week.

Road Resurfacing Update.

Contrary to letters sent out in advance, Island Roads have advised me they will not resurface **Crossfield Avenue**, **Park Road** and **Worsley Road** this year. These roads were removed due to the structural integrity being higher than many other roads across the Island. However, **Tilbury Road** has been resurfaced, whilst (as many residents know) and a hazardous section of **Newport Road** was been patched.

St Mary's Roundabout.

Work to reconfigure St Mary's Roundabout is due to commence on 30th September. Following calls I received regarding the Newport Road resurfacing and the initial delays when work started, I suggest motorists consider alternative routes into Newport particularly at peak times to avoid delays. A webpage has been created to give updates and real-time information. This is available at: http://www.islandroads.com/182-newport-st-marys-strategic-junction-improvements-html Updates will also be relayed via on-site information boards and Twitter.

Pavement Parking.

I continue to receive complaints from residents with push chairs and wheelchairs regarding pavement parking. If there is no off-road provision, please ensure there is space for all pedestrians to pass safely.

Garden Waste Bins.

I've received a complaint that Amey are removing Garden Waste bins in cases where renewals have not been taken up. If this applies to you and you still have not renewed your subscription please call 823777.

Brexit Preparations.

It is very clear from the Prime Minister that the UK will be leaving the European Union on 31st October. In recent weeks government has issued advice to Businesses, EU Nationals and residents on options. This can be found here: https://www.gov.uk/prepare-eu-exit In the meantime, I've contacted the IW Council for advice for those with long term medical conditions and the availability of medication, should there be any uncertainties. Once received this information will feature on my website!

Consultation on Concessionary Travel Scheme Changes.

Following feedback I've responded to this consultation on the withdrawal by the IW Council of travel concessions for disabled residents travelling before 9:30am. In my response, I raised concerns over how this concession allows working age residents with disabilities to access work and feel included. This is not only positive for residents with physical disabilities but also those susceptible to mental health needs. I note working aged residents with disabilities, are twice as likely to be living in poverty, and are more likely to suffer from social isolation, anxiety and depression. In my view, withdrawal of this concession may increase the long term costs to the IW Council and healthcare providers.

Planning Updates.

Bucklers View- I am awaiting an update regarding concerns raised over increasing the scale and mass of this extension.

Church Road- Dialogue has taken place between myself, the applicant and planners. I'm hopeful a compromise can be found by the case officer.

Westview Road. Planners initially indicated they share mine, residents and Gurnard Parish Councils concern over any residential use west of existing properties.

Woodvale Road. Following resident's concerns, this application was withdrawn.

The Range. I continue to lobby for the pedestrian refuge for Place Road. This is being chased!

Planning Enforcement: This continues for applications adjacent to Egypt Hill and Westview Road.

Cowes 2020: 200 Update.

Many thanks to the feedback received so far on identifying 200 extra parking spaces in Cowes for residents and visitors to the town.

My intention is to create these spaces by:

Removing residents parking 'bays'. Each box measures 4.8 metres, when in reality the space needed is less. I estimate for every 11-12 bays removed 1 extra space could be created.

Can unused off-road driveways and garages be made available that can offer residents a small nominal income from commuters thus freeing up space elsewhere?

Can existing public and private car parks be better utilised, by reconfiguration. Is long /short stay car parking fit for purpose? Are there parts of the town that needs better disabled parking provision?

Are there areas where historic double yellow lines exist, that are no longer needed?

Do you know of disabled bays no longer used?

In the discussions that I have had with the many residents that have contacted me, I am confident that we can find 200 spaces before the end of next year.

If you have any thoughts, ideas or suggestions please let me know.

GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL REPORT

At September's meeting of the Parish Council, Councillors agreed to formally write to Island Roads following an unprecedented number of complaints received regarding the signage, one-way system and

ensuing traffic chaos on the seafront during Cowes Week and have

requested to have sight of the temporary Cowes Week order next year, 6 weeks prior to Cowes week, to review and ensure there is better planning and management.

There is a new vacancy for a Councillor to serve on Gurnard Parish Council. For more information please contact the Clerk. Applications to be received by 31 October 2019 to be considered at Full Council on 13 November 2019.

Three tenders were received to recondition the public toilets on Gurnard Green and the Parish Council have agreed to go ahead with a Danfo Modulet system (the same as those at the Falcon Cross site in Shanklin installed by Shanklin Town Council) which will be ready by May 2020 in time for next summer.

Old School Meadow has had a final cut and tidy for the year. Should anyone be interested in getting involved with the upkeep of Old School Meadow moving forward, please contact the Clerk who will pass on names to the Old School Meadow Working Group.

Maintenance of the large plant beds along Worsley Road are also proving a problem for the Gurnard in Bloom team - if you are able to help in anyway please get in touch.
