

Trees. Highways Trees.

Last month I received a complaint of a healthy highway tree removed by Island Roads in Worsley Road.

Following further investigation, I am advised that any tree found leaning onto the highway by more than 20 degrees will be removed for health and safety grounds. Island Roads advise when any tree is removed, an arboriculture assessment takes place and trees removed will be replaced. To note, this tree is due to be replaced this winter.

Woodland Tree works, Worsley Road.

I've received feedback concerning a proposal to manage 1.2 hectares of woodland northwest of Worsley Road.

The report highlights the risk from ash dieback, and confirmation given that trees will be felled and replaced. It is proposed woodland will be thinned by 10% in year one to remove 'congestion' and to improve arboriculture management. This will

be followed by further thinning by 5% each year for 4 years to increase light, biodiversity and should provide a range of trees without large impact to wildlife or stress to retained trees, according to proposals.

Details can be found on the IW Council's public access website, with the reference number: 19/01592/TW.

Highways Meeting.

Later this month, I am meeting with highways officers on site to discuss the following matters:

- Loading bays and access, Bath Road.
- Commuter parking concerns, Crossfield Avenue and School Parking arrangements, Baring Road.
- Improving mobility access, Park Road.
- Improving access/ site lines to and from Glen Place at the junction with Worsley Road.
- Improved waymarking to the Portland Inn.
- Monitoring traffic speeds and the potential flow of traffic in and to Cockleton Lane.

Improving drainage in Rew Street.

Please let me know if there are any other stretches of road which are causing issues!

Planning Meeting.

I am meeting with the Head of Planning to discuss updating Gurnard's Neighbourhood Plan. From my perspective, I would like to see the IW Council doing more to protect green gaps, particularly those separating Cowes from Northwood and Gurnard. This is particularly relevant given proposals to increase housing numbers to 675 per year.

In addition, myself and Gurnard Parish Councillors will also be highlighting tree loss concerns.

St Mary's Roundabout. Next phases 5-6: 2nd January to 8th June 2020 (Update from Island Roads).

During this phase, a contraflow system — taking the traffic onto the opposite side of the carriageway will be in place for traffic travelling on Medina Way, north of St Mary's roundabout. From early January to late March, the contraflow will be in place for southbound traffic heading towards Newport. It will then switch to a contraflow for northbound traffic (Cowes-bound). Signage will be in place to clearly direct vehicles, including those exiting from the hospital site onto Medina Way, to exit via a feeder lane. General Election.

It was good to catch up with residents at both the Northwood Cricket Club and Gurnard Village Hall who cast their votes for our Member of Parliament. Turnout was 65.9% (a 1.4% downturn from 2017).

Town and Parish Council Meeting with IW Council.

Prior to the election, with Town/ Parish Councillors I attended a meeting with the IW Council to discuss future levels of support the Council requiring to protect public services. Despite positivity from political candidates to end austerity, there remains no commitment from government to support public services. Given uncertainties on the Local Government Settlement, Brexit, the Fair funding review, an Island Deal and Business Rate retention it remains unknown to what extent Town and Parish Council's will need to to plug the gap to fund discretionary services. As a result, local councils were asked to expect the worse...

Highways Issues.

Shore Road was closed in December to conclude construction work required for a property.

Urgent repairs took place to repair damage to the pavement on Princes Esplanade. An abandoned vehicle was reported in Baring Road, and action has been taken to see its removal

Also last month.

I am offering support to a resident who has been chased for disputed Council Tax arrears.

During Christmas, I supported a number of residents approached by a Double Glazing firm, cold calling.

I am chasing a number of Planning Enforcement matters (all in Gurnard).

I have requested support from Island Roads on a tree that is leaning (very much in excess of 20 degrees!)

Cowes Enterprise College is addressing concerns over the noise of hirers using the new football pitch. The college has agreed to improve signage and liaise hirers.

I supported proposals to improve ice skating facilities, by supporting proposals a Smallbrook

I have provided support to residents with concerns over proposals to drill for oil in the Arreton Valley.

I continue to support a business owner over improving access for the disabled.

I have contacted the MP on behalf of a resident over a nil response to an Enquiry made several months ago.

I have nominated a resident to become a school governor at Cowes Primary

I continued to receive complaints concerning overfilled and unemptied bins.

GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL

At December and January's meeting of the Parish

Council it was resolved to set the precept at £59,000

for 2020/21, a small increase of 1.72% on last year's

precept which was £58,000. Any remaining balance at
the end of the financial year will be ring fenced towards a future

project to upgrade the playground.

Councillors are liaising with Island Roads over a tree on Worsley Road that has been cut down, apparently due to it leaning into the highway, and two further trees on Solent View Road. Although Island Roads have confirmed they do not need to consult with the Parish Council about any such action, we have asked if there can be a substantial replacement, and to inform us if there are plans for any further removal of trees which are such a valuable asset to the village. Councillors are liaising with the IWC's Tree Officer over proposed tree work at Gurnard Cliff as they are particularly concerned about the ecological impact and ground stability should 30% of the trees be felled over the next 5 years as is being suggested.

The Gurnard in Bloom team have asked if volunteers can support their small team already in existence by helping with nearby watering and weeding of plants. It is hoped that Island Roads will help with more of the beds on Worsley Road, but the plants at the top of the Avenue and Albert Road could do with some attention. It has been noted that there are regularly up to 3 cars parked in Old School Meadow, and while the field has approval for occasional parking for maintenance etc. there isn't permission for general public use. The visibility splay to the right of the exit from the field is insufficient and doesn't comply with highway access regulations. The Parish Council have agreed to install a pedestrian gate to enable access at the main entrance but will need to ask that there is No Parking in the field please, except in exceptional circumstances.

BT are proposing to remove two phone boxes in Gurnard; one on Solent View Road and the other outside the Woodvale, but given their low usage, Councillors have not objected to their removal.

This year's Annual Parish Meeting will be held at 6.30pm on Wednesday 29th April where we are hoping to have a presentation on the new English Coastal Path. We would love to see as many members of the public as possible in attendance - refreshments will be provided. We will also be presenting the Parish Award at this meeting.

We have been approached by YOU First Domestic Abuse Service on the Isle of Wight seeking volunteers to participate in their Dragonfly Project which supports victims of domestic abuse. Further details are available on the Noticeboard

The Parish Council is inviting Grant Applications from organisations who can demonstrate their benefit to the village. Please download an application form from the website and return it by the end of March, to be decided at April's meeting. Finally the Parish Council has recently replaced its Colour Laser Printer and would like to donate it to a worthy cause – if you know of any organisations please pass on your suggestions to the Clerk.


