#### A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

Hello my friends,

We live in unprecedented times and as I write this piece for the Newsletter, the Covid-19 virus (or Coronavirus) is having a huge impact upon our lives.

It is in these times of uncertainty that our community spirit, that we value so much, comes into action significantly. The good that is within us all, reaches out to those in need, to those who are vulnerable and to the fearful.

Hope, as I've said before, is a basic human necessity, without it we can quickly lose our purpose in life, with it, anything is possible.



#### Baring Road Planning Applications. Ref: 19/01578/FUL and 20/00188/FUL.

I have called-in both parallel applications (the first for 6 dwellings, the second for 4) on fields between Greenacres and the Farm Bungalow.

This is due to the fact that any development will close the green gap between Cowes and Gurnard, is outside the settlement boundary and that development would have an adverse impact upon the landscape characteristics of the Jordan Valley.

#### Westview Road. Ref: 20/00145/FUL

A further application has been received to create a further 'residential' dwelling on agricultural land west of Rew Street. This application is in the countryside, and although 'prior approval', was given for residential use of a barn nearby, this is a brand new proposal in an area outside the settlement boundary.

#### Cowes/ Gurnard Car Parking Charges.

To raise more revenue, the IW Council are pursuing proposals to charge for parking on Cowes/ Gurnard Seafront. I am totally opposed to these unpopular proposals, particularly given the cost of maintenance and the impact that this will have upon established and new businesses.

Despite myself and my group putting alternative budget proposals forward, Councillors from the ruling group agreed to forge ahead with the suggestion In light of their decision, I am advised that the statutory consultation will take place-However timescales has to be agreed.

#### Floodlighting, 3G Pitch Cowes Enterprise College.

I continue to receive feedback from residents of Ward Avenue and Baring Road over floodlighting, noise and loss of amenity/ privacy.

On this, a meeting has been arranged with Environmental Health for advice. One thing that I have noted is the lack of landscaping and screening which was part of the original approval in 2010. From my perspective, this was a key reason for me not objecting, and I have expressed concerns over this.

#### **Public Spaces Protection Order Consultation.**

The IW Council are consulting on the above, following initial concerns over access to dogs. #### Bucklers View Update. Ref: 19/00080/FUL

A meeting between Southern Housing and Bucklers View Residents was intended to take place to address concerns over drainage at the site, as well as a hands up on the proposals to extend. In speaking to Southern Housing, I understand that construction will not commence within six months. Therefore, it seems very unlikely that information sharing/ public meeting will not take place until contractors have been procured and a traffic management is in place in draft form.

A conference call with officers is due to take place with officers early next month.

#### Gurnard Primary School.

I continue to receive complaints from parents and residents over dangerous parking. As a consequence of the minority of parents who park dangerously, consideration is being given to introducing a no waiting/ no loading restriction removing the 5 minutes grace allowing the collection and pick up children.

In addition, suggestions have been taken on board to make the cycle lane car free. Last month at a meeting called to discuss options it was agreed to pursue this as well as increasing parking capacity within 5 minutes walk of the school.

#### Rolls Hill/Road.

A meeting took place between residents, the Police and Island Roads to discuss concerns over speeding traffic using Rolls Hill and Roads Hill Road.

Following the speed being monitored and in light of average speeds being in excess of 50mph, I am supporting calls for an 'Emergency Speed Limit' being in force during the improvements works at St Mary's junction. On this, I am attempting to arrange a meeting with IW Council Officers, Councillors and residents.

#### Sail GP.

The first meeting of residents who will be affected by this years Sail GP event met with organisers and Council Officers. Following the first meeting, follow up meetings will take place, whilst updates will take place by email.

It was reported that this year there will be no grandstand, whilst an official ticketed area will be in place opposite the New Holmwood Hotel.

Since the meeting Sail GP have met with Cowes Week Ltd and Island Roads and are working towards a 'cohesive traffic management plan', which will be developed ahead of this month's meeting, with an aim to share this in April.

In addition, progress is being made for a park and ride 'Sail Bus'. The feasibility of this is being evaluated.

#### Place Road.

With houses being built on Place Road, I have been asked for consideration being made to reduce the speed limit to 30mph. On this, before I proceed please let me know your thoughts!

Also within Place Road, I continue to chase up the promised **Pedestrian Refuge** for the Range. I have received confirmation that the **tree** lost in storms on the grass verge opposite Deauville Drive last October will be replaced in the coming weeks. In addition I'm told that discussions have taken place between the developer of **Meadow View** and residents following boundary hedges being removed. The developer has advised planners that 'boundaries and screening will be improved in the long term'...

#### **GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL**

Gurnard Parish Council have chosen to award the Gurnard News Team with the Parish Award this year in recognition of their outstanding contribution to the village. It is a big team of around 30 volunteers from



Parish Council the Editor, to those involved with printing and advertising, folding

and making up the magazines, and the 21 volunteers delivering the finished article come rain or shine. A huge thank you from the Parish Council! We were very much hoping to present the Team with their award at the Annual Parish Meeting on 29th April 2020, but it looks very likely that this, as with so many other events planned, might have to be postponed to a later date.

There will be an extraordinary meeting of the Parish Council in the next few days (23rd March 2020) to make a decision and put contingency arrangements in place in light of the restrictions imposed by the Covid-19 virus. Sadly the CPR training due to be delivered by St John Ambulance has already been postponed and it is likely that the Litter Pick planned for April 4th will also be postponed. Please check the website and noticeboard for updates.

We have a vacancy for a new member to serve on the Parish Council. If you are interested in becoming a Councillor please contact the Clerk for further information. Expressions of interest are invited by the end of April to be considered in May.

Natural England have just released their recommendations for the English Coast Path route https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/england-coast-path-on-the-isle-of-wight-comment-on-proposals and the Parish Council will be formulating any representations they consider relevant about these proposals to the Secretary of State, and residents are invited to do the same, by 13th May 2020.

Prior to a consultation on the IWC's proposed parking charges on the seafront, Gurnard Parish Council have made their objections strongly known to ClIr lan Ward, Cabinet Member for Infrastructure & Transport, and we would urge as many people as possible to write individual letters of response as soon as the consultation begins.

Councillors have had further site meetings with the builders refurbishing the toilets on Gurnard Green and pleased to report all is going well and on schedule. The new toilets are due to open on Wednesday 8th April.

Councillors have a approved a budget to recruit the services of the Conservation

Volunteers' Green Gym who we are hoping will assist Gurnard in Bloom to tidy the flower beds on Worsley Road.

Thank you to residents who have already expressed an interest in Community Speed Watch to tackle speeding on Cockleton Lane. As the scheme requires either the hire or purchase of fairly costly equipment (approximately £3000), it might be that we can join forces with Cowes Town Council, should they decide to put funding towards equipment, and so we await a decision from them.

Lots of issues have been raised by Councillors recently which have been reported to Island Roads including a long stretch of green slime on the pavement on the seafront, slime returning outside of the Woodvale Pub, a shopping trolley dumped full of rubbish below the Green, bins left on pavements, and broken fencing causing obstruction.

Complaints about cars parking too far onto the pavement on Place Road have been carried forward for discussion and action as soon as Councillors have an opportunity to next meet.




