A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

HELLO THERE

I hope this letter finds you OK? Another month has gone by and still we write to you virtually: whilst it is not the same as holding the magazine in your hand, this is still a small way that we can reach out to all of you within our community – I hope you enjoy it!

Do you remember the film called 'The Story of Dr Dolittle', starring Rex Harrison including that most strange of animals called a Pushmi-Pullyu? Depicted as a two headed llama, with heads at either end of its body, it symbolises things which are conflicting or contradictory.

Well for the past 14 weeks, our entire nation has been in a state of getting and giving a mixture of advice, guidance and notifications which has left most of us feeling that we are being pulled in two different directions. How do we stay safe and yet have access to fresh food, supplies and medicine? How do we keep in contact with others when we have to stay indoors and possibly have not yet mastered new technology? How do we still prioritise the things which up until mid-March seemed so important and yet now are not available to us? How do we keep our mental health buoyant when others around us seem to be crumbling?

The Church here in the UK has come under a lot of scrutiny recently and many opinions have been aired as to what part churches have played in keeping us safe as a nation but also spiritually nourished. As a ministry team, we have been doing our 'job' in a way we have never done before: we have mastered new skills, learning how to YouTube, get the perfect angle for laptops, teach people how to turn their microphones on and lead services whilst helping people access Zoom and other online worship. It has certainly been an interesting ride.....!

But now after three months of lockdown we are slowly and cautiously being given more freedom; we're not out of the woods yet but thankfully there are positive signs that the virus no longer has the hold on the country that it did. As we begin to come out and we're able to do some of the things we took for granted before, and as we begin to socialise more, I think each one of us will discover that the Covid-19 Virus has changed us in some way. Some have tragically lost loved ones through this time, some have lost jobs and incomes, some have been furloughed whilst others have been working harder than ever. Some have lost precious planned events; family parties and celebrations, baptisms and weddings have had to be re-scheduled. End of year proms, exams, holidays and a whole host of other things precious to us have been lost too... and that will have taken its toll on us all.

And as we slowly see restrictions being lifted, new challenges arise and we have to

make decisions as to what is best for our own context and circumstances. Worship has taken place at Gurnard Church for over 125 years and yet we realise that we cannot just reopen our doors for public gatherings and services like we did before we had even heard the word Coronavirus.

So, as we begin to look forward... as we begin to dare to plan and consider what the future will look like let us try and find ways of taking the positive things we've learned and experienced through lockdown forward with us. And I'd like to encourage you to look with me to another promise God has for each one of us. This is what God says in Jeremiah 29:11 to us: "For I know the plans I have for you," declares the LORD, "plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future."

We have been through an incredibly tough time... we're not quite through it yet but we're getting there ...and wonderfully there is hope and future ahead of us. If you would like a place to pause and reflect, a place to perhaps mourn or to be thankful, then please do come and spend some time in any of our churches. We're now allowed to have people come to the church buildings, (we can't meet for services yet) but individually we can come in to reflect and pray... so you're very welcome to just come and be in that space. We are currently open Tuesday and Friday 11am-1pm. If a church building isn't your thing then let me encourage you to find a special place where you are able to 'pause'.

And if you'd like to talk through any of this stuff with me then please get in touch, I'd love to hear from you. Whichever way, be assured you, our community and the island as a whole remain firmly in my thoughts and prayers.

Gurnard Green and Gurnard Beach.

In recent weeks a number of 'volunteers' have continued to tidy up both the beach and Gurnard Green of litter. Although, I recognise this is much appreciated by residents this can be dangerous.

If visiting the Green or the beach, please ensure rubbish is left inside a bin or taken home, as waste left outside bins can and are frequently scattered by badgers and foxes who visit at night.

A major issue again this year is use of **disposable barbecues**. Although use is restricted at the Green and on the beach, I still receive numerous complaints each

year of harm caused by barbecues when discarded

In the meantime, I have requested that the beach, the Green and litter is monitored. I have also asked for the police to step up patrols following incidents which have impacted upon residents living nearby.

Jet Ski's

The use of jet ski's have been reported to the Marine Police, who I pleased to report have continued to monitor their use in waters frequented by bathers. Please note a local bye-law exists prohibiting 'Personal Watercraft' being used faster than 8 knots and in depths of less than 2 metres.

Planning Applications.

Applications are pending approval for a holiday home at Shore Path and residential use of a barn located off Westview Road, which was previously accepted under a Prior Approval application.

At **Shore Path**, following historical issues, I requested safeguards to protect the integrity of the sea wall.

At **Westview Road** following feedback, conditions were requested and accepted by planners restricting future permitted development rights. In addition, I have requested further conditions safeguarding visual impact, light spillage and requesting landscaping to support wildlife and the natural environment.

Bucklers View.

Southern Housing are still considering ongoing issues concerning drainage. From their perspective they are seeking to find a solution that will be the least disruptive to residents before extending the complex next year.

Cowes/ Northwood Place Plan.

Work has commenced on a Place Plan to regenerate Cowes and Northwood. Local Council's, Cowes Business Association and the IW Council need help with essential information. Environmental Issues.

Noisy Tools.

Panel Beating, Angle Grinders, Electric Saws and general car fumbling are more popular than ever. If you're planning a big job that will be noisy please let your neighbours know in advance.

Barking Dogs.

Each year, I receive many calls concerning barking dogs. If you are away from your pets for long periods, please consider your pets and neighbours who can find this distressing.

Garden Bonfires.

I continue to receive complaints concerning bonfires. If you have a bonfire, please ensure this is supervised with caution taken to ensure those living within dips and valleys nearby are not affected.

Fireworks.

I received a call concerning Clapping for Carers, and a resident celebrating their appreciation by lighting a firework each week. Although this was not unlawful the individual stopped when they found out the distress this caused to the callers pet. If you choose to light fireworks please let nearby residents know!

Cowes Events.

As mentioned last month, organisers of the SailGP 2020 postponed this event to next year, as has the Cowes Torquay Cowes Powerboat Race which takes place late August. In the meantime, Cowes Week is still intending to go ahead. If Cowes Week 2020 does go ahead, with social distancing rules it is likely to be on a much smaller scale. Because the event very much depends upon advice from Government, an update will be made in July.

Highways Issues.

Ward Estate Wall.

A resident contacted me about concerns they had concerning the condition of the Ward Estate Wall, which runs alongside the northern section of Park Road and eastern and southern section of Baring Road. Of particular concern is the section between the Roundhouse and the Community Club. I have forwarded comments to Island Roads who are liaising with Building Control on the structural integrity of this section.

Overgrown Hedges.

Overgrown hedges at the following locations:

Baring Road (between junction with Woodvale Road and opposite junction with Crossfield Avenue.)

Tuttons Hill (northern section), Crossfield Avenue (hedge bordering Cowes Enterprise College),

Place Road (between Broadfields Avenue and the southern junction of Place Side) Worsley Road. Winding Way.

Also:

With the lockdown easing, requests for larger buses were requested for residents wishing to go to and from Freshwater. In addition, extra services on the Community Bus and Service 1 from Cowes to Newport were requested.

On this Southern Vectis has been very receptive and helpful. Thank You!

A big thank you to volunteers and residents who helped fund and repair the Mornington Wood pond.

The Police ask residents to ensure homes, cars and sheds are locked and kept secure following opportunistic walk in burglaries that occur this time of year. A request has been made by Plaza to sell ice creams on the seafront between Cowes and Gurnard.

I received a warning from dog walkers of snakes frequenting the Gurnard to Thorness Coastal Path. They are more afraid of humans than we are of them!

My name is David Mortimer and I live in Whitwell, Isle of Wight.

I have been metal detecting with kind permission here on the Island since 2006, searching Farmland and land in private ownership, such as Manors sites and other old properties with land of More than an Acre in size. Along the way my wife and I have been fortunate enough to find coins and artefacts from the Bronze Age to the modern day, including some items of value and others that have been declared Treasure.



I am writing this now in the hope that a Farmer/Landowner in your area may be willing to allow my wife and I to search their land with our metal detectors. We are not members of a Club. We have insurance coverage. We are willing to pay £5 each for the privilege of searching the land that may be offered for us to detect upon. We also have a good reputation.




All finds will be shown and anything of value will be bought to the attention of the Farmer/Landowner. We usually agree to a 50/50 division of finds made or payment of half the relevant value of the items found, of course other arrangements can be made such as a donation of the find/finds to the Islands museum. Anything that may be deemed of interest to Mr. Basford will be recorded by him on the Portable Antiquities Scheme Database of Finds, which lists ancient artefacts and coins found in the whole of Great Britain. An Agreement Form can be provided if the Farmer/Landowner wishes to have everything in writing, we prefer to do things this way in any



The agreement we have with some (not all) Farmers/Landowners is that they would pay us half the relevant value of any finds of consequence that they wish to keep, and then they also get to keep the rest of the finds that are made on their property because I believe that they should stay in their ownership as a collection.

If you have not considered having someone conduct a search of your land and/or property, please contact me if you wish to do so and we can discuss this matter further.


