A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

Hello friends,

Goodness me it's been a while since I was able to speak to you directly via the Newsletter. I really do hope that this Newsletter finds you in good spirits as we begin to look around from the closed door of lockdown. These past months have certainly been a very difficult time for us and we are far from back to normal just yet.

Over these past months I have once again been moved at how our communities have pulled together to help one another out. The milk of human kindness stretches a long way when we are faced with such deeply troubling times. As I see and hear of situations where neighbours and friends have gone to such great lengths to ensure, those who are more vulnerable, are cared for, my heart is filled with a degree of happiness.

I say a degree of happiness because I wish the difficult time had not been there in the first place, but life has a habit of throwing us in these situations from time to time doesn't it?

The way we rally around and help one another shows me how God created us as inherently good at our birth. Sadly, for some people, life experiences can lead them down a path that can end up bringing more difficulties and challenges than the average person. But that does not alter my view that at the heart of all individuals, caring for others in time of need is something we all try to do.

When I attend church it is this thought that lies at the front of my mind. It is at those times that I give thanks to God for all that is good in the world starting with the kindness of individuals who are often strangers to one another, but who wish to make life that little bit easier for others. When I see these attributes in people, it leads me to have a deeper sense of God in my day to day life. Seeing the best in people, seeing how we come together in times of difficulty and try to help one another brings me that sense of wholeness and peace that I feel we all need in life.

In recent weeks I have been talking a lot about our sense of the spiritual at church, how we find that sense of what can make us feel at peace and bring us closer to that feeling of wholeness in our lives. I've often said that God is in everything that is holy, good and peaceful. The only thing that that can limit our awareness of God is our imagination, and then when we gather together, normally on a Sunday, we can share those moments with one another and strengthen our sense of the spiritual and the bond that exists between us all.

I feel this is when our sense of God can be at its strongest. But the very nature of all that is spiritual is when it is personal to us because each one of us will have a unique sense of what makes us find that peace and wholeness in our life.

So as I write this brief piece for us today, let me ask you, what is it that brings you to that place of wholeness and peace, that special place that you can go to when you feel under stress and are in need of a little spiritual refreshment, because I do sincerely believe that we all need to have this in our lives.

For some of us finding quiet in the midst of a busy chaotic life can bring us a degree of calm, whereas some of us have too much quiet in our lives and long for more human contact. Finding peace and that sense of wholeness is more about finding ourselves and seeking that path that brings us closer to finding our identity in life, and when we do we can often gain that sense of the spiritual in our lives.

I look back over these past months and I reflect upon all that has tested our resolve, that has tested our strength of character, that has created a stronger sense of community and has brought us closer together. I offer thanks to God for all those opportunities that have given us a stronger sense of the good that is within us all and has often created a stronger sense of identity within each of us. As we journey on through life, my prayer for us all is that through that mutual support we will become stronger still and we will rediscover all that connects us with our sense of the spiritual, our sense of God, and we will find that degree of peace and wholeness that we need in our life.

Surgeries Update.

Thank you to the very lovely Rod Ainge and Karen from **Eegons Cafe**, who accommodated my last Thursday of the month surgeries.

Rods ear, his ideas, support and free cuppas were very much welcomed throughout this time, and I was very sad to hear premises where Eegons had been trading from had been sold!

Surgerywise, I'm searching for a new venue in Cowes, to follow a new surgery being relocated to the Café at Gurnard Pines. Having spoken to the Café, if all goes well, in the future I'm hoping to hold drop-in's with the CAB and other support groups... The surgery takes place 11:30am- noon on either the third or fourth Thursday of each month.

St Mary's junction.

In recent weeks there have been regular delays occur at this junction. This follows work commencing on the more difficult aspects of the scheme. I anticipate delays will become commonplace between now and December. Please visit: http://islandroads.com/newport-st-marys-strategic-junction-improvements/ for updates. In response, as well as calls to Island Roads, I've asked for incidents of anti-social driving is monitored.

Supporting local businesses: Use them or lose them?

A large number of local businesses continue to be impacted by the downturn in custom. This is particularly relevant to pubs, café's and small shops- all which desperately seek our support. If you can shop local, please shop local as our community needs all the support we as residents we can give! This is not only important for shops themselves, but to those who depend upon jobs and the local interaction that help make our local community thrive. In the meantime, I'm speaking to the IW Council about doing all they can to ensure our towns flourish. Although I received a complaint concerning the 20p cost, this charge is necessary to help maintain the toilets and is a small contribution from beach/ Green users rather than just Gurnard precept payers. During the transferral of toilets by the IW Council, residents suggested they would prefer to pay a charge than lose toilets all together. Subsequently where toilets have been replaced, there is likely to be a charge. This has happened in Shanklin and for toilets planned in Newport.

Active Travel funding to improve access for Cyclists.

IW Councillors were contacted concerning 'Active Travel' funding from Government. This follows Covid-19 issues raised to improve pedestrian and particularly cycling access. In light of this, we were advised of a proposal to reconfigure traffic flows to allow a new cycle route into Cowes.

Following feedback from councillors, I've suggested for more to be done to re-route cycles from the pedestrianised town, whilst increasing public access to the shoreside. This is also being looked into.

Place Road new Pedestrian Refuge.

Following perseverance a new refuge emerged in Place Road to make it safe for pedestrians crossing the road to The Range and Aldi. It was a long time coming, but thank you for your patience

Gurnard Green Toilets.

Toilets at Gurnard Green recently refurbished by Gurnard Parish Council reopened in July. Following snagging, the large majority of residents has welcomed the new facilities. My grateful thanks to Gurnard Parish Council for their commitment on this.

Anti-Social Behaviour.

I continue to receive feedback concerning noise nuisance and anti-social behaviour following gatherings on Gurnard Beach. From June's police report all four reported crimes related to incidents in Gurnard occurred in relation to or during the aftermath of beach gatherings. This followed my request for the police to increase their presence. Although four reported crimes are not a lot, it does demonstrate a need!

Coronavirus Update.

As things start to revert to normal, myself and Cllr Peacey Wilcox are working with Community Action and the IW Council.

I am working on a local plan to set out locally who does what, and where volunteers can plug any gaps should a second wave emerge. In the meantime updates can be found at: https://www.gov.uk/coronavirus

Trees, Hedges and Bushes.

Bird nesting season ended in August. This will allow roadside, footway and public rights of way hedges to have more of a significant trim. Please let me know of sites where access is impaired.

Over the summer, I supported residents with neighbours overgrown bushes, hedges and trees. To note:

- There is no general requirement that all hedges should be kept below a certain height.
- O There is no limit to the height of a hedge or a tree in a garden.
- There is no law prohibiting the planting of leylandii trees.
 There is no such thing as an automatic 'right to light' or a view.

Also this month:

- Environmental Health were notified concerning safety after the build-up of timber off Place Road. Subsequently after my calls, the Fire Brigade was called out following an impromptu bonfire.
- A further application has been received to construct an additional two dwellings at The Dottens.
- Concerns were raised regarding taxi operators not using face coverings. This was reported to Licensing Officers, who advised that although drivers can refuse to accept customers not prepared to wear masks, there is no legal requirement on drivers to shield or do the same.

- Island Roads are intending to name the new development in Egypt Hill, Monterey Close.




