#### A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

#### Hello there!

November is traditionally the month when we remember – firstly Guy Fawkes and his disagreement with the Government on Bonfire Night and then more significantly all those who have been or continue to be involved in war and conflicts around the world on Remembrance Day. Even though there are many of us (ahem, surely it is not just me?!) who may need the odd post-it here and there to remember things to do or what to buy, I think all of us confidently say on Remembrance Sunday 'We will remember them'. I am confident in that because the two World Wars and subsequent conflicts were so traumatic that we cannot etch them from our memory. But how strange it will be to only have a few poppy sellers around and no Royal British Legion concert at the Royal Albert Hall on the TV? Yes, it is going to be a very different season of Remembrance this year.....but then everything is different isn't it, and in itself memorable – who is EVER going to forget 2020??

Yes, it is going to be abnormal, but we must nevertheless still stop and remember those we have lost in recent conflicts or past wars, the veterans still carrying memories of battle and those still serving, especially those in conflicts area. We must remember those left behind to grieve and those still suffering with their injuries mental or physical......but perhaps we also need to remember the unemployed who see no light at the end of the tunnel, the single parent who cries themselves to sleep each night not knowing how they will cope tomorrow, the elderly person living on their own missing terribly their groups and get together they used to attend, the professional trying and failing to juggle work and home life, the student who has gone to university and become isolated in their room, the child who is missing their play dates and birthday parties with friends.

In this most unique of years, I think we must still do our duty and remember the fallen, but also this year I feel we need to remember the 'falling'.....those who need help now. Here. Immediately. All around us.

I am aware that professionals talk about children building resilience so they are able to cope with challenges they face in years to come, but I have never heard anyone talking about us adults requiring to top up on our resilience through our lives! I certainly will need to this year! Children are encouraged to express their feelings, tell their parents and carers how they feel, if only us adults could rid truly ourselves of our inhibitions and do the same: cry with our ageing parents, show our fear to our friends, admit defeat to our children.... and yet it seems that British 'stiff upper lip' comes out too often!

Yes of course, we have all shown that 'stiff upper lip-ness' sometimes in our lives – it worked brilliantly in the World Wars, when we got 'knocked over but brushed

ourselves down, got back up and got on with it'. We have seen that great British spirit again during this pandemic with people helping neighbours and communities becoming closer again, Steve talked last month in his parish mag article of finding those things that give you a buzz, a lift...... but there comes a point when we all have to say 'help, I cannot do this on my own'

There is a song out at the moment by Jessie J called 'Who you are' and part of the chorus is very apt for this year:

### It's okay not to be okay

Sometimes it's hard, to follow your heart Tears don't mean you're losing, everybody's bruising Just be true to who you are.

I tell my boys that's all I want them to do - to be true to themselves. It's another one of those saying that us adults are good at saying but perhaps not so good at actually doing! BBC Radio Solent is currently running a campaign called 'Pledge to talk' where they are asking its listeners to make a pledge to talk to someone who they haven't spoken to in a while, or at all, with the aim of checking in on how they are to try and combat loneliness and isolation.'

A quick call lasting 10 minutes or so could literally make someone's day or even week! And if you are unable to make a call, instead try and keep someone in your thoughts and prayers, or smile at a weary looking person in Aldi, or chat to the lonely person on the bus: So lets remember the falling as well as the fallen this November. Remember those around you, in your road and street or community and be there for each other, in times of joy as well as sorrow.

By doing this we could, together, make this year the greatest and most supportive Remembrance we have ever experienced.




to look forward to as we get closer to Christmas.

### **GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL REPORT**

- Gurnard Parish Council met in the village hall again in October but have taken the decision to revert to virtual meetings for the foreseeable future, with the likelihood of further restrictions being imposed as the pandemic continues through the winter.
- We now have 2 vacancies on the Parish Council following Cllr Pat Clayton's
  resignation last month (this completed a third term of office for her and we
  are grateful for all she has contributed). Councillors are champions for the
  community and give residents a voice on all decisions the Council makes. If
  you are interested in becoming a Councillor, please contact the Clerk for

- In conjunction with the Family and Friends of Rosie who have raised over £2600 for a bench to be dedicated in Rosie's memory, Gurnard Parish Council have made an official request to the Isle of Wight Council for a picnic table to be positioned on the hard standing at the bottom of Gurnard Green, both as a lasting memory to Rosie and an amenity for the village.
- Gurnard Parish Council have strongly objected to proposed parking meters
  on the seafront and are supporting a 'Change.org Petition' ahead of January
  2021 when a decision is due to be made by the Isle of Wight Cabinet. We



Due to restrictions, surgeries at the Community Club, Cowes Library and Cowes College are suspended.

#### Seafront Car Parking charges proposals.

It seems likely that the decision on whether to impose car parking charges on Cowes/ Gurnard Seafront will be taken by IW Councillors, rather than officers. As yet no date has been set.

A big thank you to everybody who commented on this ill-conceived proposal, initially intended to raise £48,000. I am uncertain precisely how many comments were received- However, I've been copied in to 157 objections so I am assuming 200-250 comments were made.

#### Flu Jabs: News from Cowes Medical Centre.

The Medical Centre are now contacting patients most at risk of flu in accordance with NHS England guidance for an appointment in October/ November. These patients will receive a text message or a letter.

Most Flu vaccines will be by appointment at our drive-through centre, with some at the Practice.

Patients 65 and over, who are not in the high risk category can be added to the waiting list. If you would like your name added to this list please call the Centre on 01983 295251 in the afternoon when phone lines are less busy

If you are aged between 50 and 64 and not in a clinical at risk group, the earliest

you will be offered a flu vaccination is November, providing the Government provides sufficient vaccine

### No Cold Calling.

I have been working with Trading Standards following roads being targeted by Cold Calling. In light of this, I've been supplied with 'No Cold Calling' stickers, and am working with our Local Councils to consider updating signs put in place when Cowes, Northwood and Gurnard became a No Cold Calling zone in 2009.

If you experience incidents, or require stickers please let me know.

### Southern Gas Road Closures, Gurnard.

Despite a shaky start with communications, my grateful thanks to the crews working throughout weekends to ensure initially that roads in Gurnard could reopen within 10 days. Sadly, several incidents were reported with residents travelling the wrong way in the one way system.

### Mobile Homes and High Sided vehicles.

Although mobile homes and high sided vehicles have no restrictions parking on the roadway, can I ask for owners to ensure vehicles are safely parked, not obscuring sight lines and not restricting residents of light.

### Gurnard Pines, Cockleton Lane.

Cockleton Lane residents have approached me concerning items inadvertently delivered to similar addresses in Gurnard Pines. On occasions 'Gurnard Pines' was omitted from the address.

In response to the fact that packages are being undelivered, I am considering making an approach to Island Roads and The Post Office suggesting Gurnard Pines becomes the street address rather than Cockleton Lane. This would overcome the ambiguity delivery drivers face. From my perspective it seems perverse that an area with three separate postcodes, is not considered a street in its own right. On this please let me know your thoughts! In the short term, could I please ask that Gurnard Pines residents ensure 'Gurnard Pines' and your postcode is included for deliveries?

#### Place Road: Speed Limit.

In light of recent developments, I have contacted Island Roads to consider a 30mph speed limit for the entirety of Place Road (currently the section between Place Side and the Northwood sign is not included)

Please let me know your thoughts!

### Planning For the Future: A developers Charter?

Under the Government white paper concerning planning, it is intended to increase housing numbers for the Island to 1045 dwellings per year. This figure has doubled from 520 four years ago.

In response, I've objected as ward Councillor to both the Council's Cabinet Member for Planning, and MP, Bob Seely, citing that increased housing figures are unsustainable, given how many applications are received, are approved, because of the fragility of the economy and Environmental Designation pressures.

I am continuing to work with Mr Seely who shares my views that new homes should be affordable, prioritised for local people and he feels also the proposed figure is unsustainable.

As an aside, pre-Covid in 2019/20 323 permissions were granted and 261 housing units completed, of which 3 units were allocated for affordable housing.

#### Full Council.

I was one of a handful of Councillors to vote against a pay increase in Councillors Allowances.

This worked well as this gave proper challenge and a voice to those who are not members of the Conservative's ruling group (who account for 40% of Councillors).


