

GURNARD PARISH COUNCIL REPORT

Gurnard Parish Council held their meeting remotely in November which looks set to continue for the foreseeable future. Members of the public are welcome to attend – please contact the Clerk for login details.

We are pleased that the IWC have confirmed we can proceed with the wishes of the Friends and Family of Rosie for a picnic table on the hard standing at the bottom of The Green. Given the popularity of these tables and space available, the Parish Council will be discussing the possibility of an additional table at their next meeting.

The Parish Council have awarded a grant of £150 to the Friends of Northwood Cemetery to support the cost of CCTV in an attempt to reduce anti-social behaviour on site.

In conjunction with the Police and Trading Standards we will be replacing the 'No Cold Calling Zone' signs around the village which have become very faded since their installation in 2007. In the meantime, if you wish to report a rogue trader please call either 101 or 823371.

The Parish Council are challenging the suggestion from the IWC that the pirate ship and butterfly in the play area may need to be removed at the end of the season as they are no longer cost effective to keep repairing. The Parish Council consider the equipment to be solid and whilst we have agreed to ring fence money to upgrade and maintain the playground in the future, we would not want this to be at the cost of the pirate ship.

Various issues have been raised with the Environment Officer for action including a dangerous build-up of seaweed on the concrete beach access steps along Princess Esplanade and fly tipping on The Green.

Seafront Parking Charges: Update.

A change.org petition has been set up to allow residents to further object to proposals to charge for parking between Egypt Light and The Woodvale. In its first week over 2400 residents had objected to proposals.

Given this, and constraints of charging all year on Cowes/ Gurnard Seafront this further fuels the argument against applying charges. Many thanks to Adam for translating my pidgeon English and developing the petition, and for residents involved in 'spreading the word'.

It's intended the IW Council's Cabinet will decide on charges, alongside those for the Somerton Park & Ride and Esplanade winter charges at its meeting on 14th January

Place Road Speed Limit.

Proposals to reduce the speed limit to **30mph** speed limit for the entire length of **Place Road** are being assessed by the IW Council and Island Roads as part of the Island wide speed limit review. In the meantime, please continue to let me know your thoughts.

Gurnard Pines.

Island Roads advise they will only remove the 'Cockleton Lane', aspect of Gurnard Pines street addresses if they receive a formal request to do so by site and unit owners of Gurnard Pines.

Planning: 20/01243/OUT Proposed Lower Church Road development for 7 dwellings.

An 'outline' planning application has been submitted to build seven dwellings between Gurnard Farm and farmland to the north to join the line of properties on the southern aspect of Lower Church Road. I have undertaken a letter drop to nearby residents. The deadline for comments is 27th November.

Planning: Old School Close, Gurnard.

An appeal was made against the planning condition for a footway outside Old School Close.

During the appeal Island Roads were successful making the point the footway was necessary in terms of safety for pedestrians using Cockleton Lane. In conclusion, the Inspector supported the condition.

Rosie's Bench.

I'm working with the family of Roanna Jardine, who sadly passed away earlier this year, and has asked for a bench to be erected in Rosie's memory. With Gurnard Parish Council's Chairman, Terry Nolan I met with Rosie's mum and a site has been agreed for the bench's location. A positive meeting later followed with Council Officers.

Taxi's.

With drive-thru flu vaccines, and many residents dependent on taxis there is real concern being expressed by some residents. Government guidance stipulates 'Whilst it is not mandatory for taxi and PHV drivers to wear face coverings you are strongly advised to do so in order to protect yourself and others' In light of this advice for drivers providing essential transport, I hold the view that operators require greater support for the service they offer.

Speedwatch Volunteers.

Volunteers are still required to support the local Speedwatch initiative. If interested, please let me know!

Crisis Support.

A number of residents have been in touch concerning support for families on low incomes. Because of the recent 2 week half term break, the position locally is more acute than in other parts of the country. In response, I am working alongside colleagues to ensure families are better supported. Following feedback from the initial vote by Government on School Meals Support during school holidays, the Isle of Wight Council are directing residents to the Help Through Crisis Fund.






