### b. <u>Clerk's Report</u>

The Clerk circulated her report prior to the meeting and raised an opportunity to access 75% funding for the installation of an on-street electric vehicle charging point which will be agenda'd for consideration in September. A request has been received from the Chair or Gurnard Village Hall Association (GVHA) about the possibility of raising the threshold of GPC's financial regulation (requiring all work and contracts to be subject to at least 2 quotations) to £5000 and members asked for GVHA to provide further rationale for this request in order for the Clerk to make the necessary legal enquiries.

IW Cllr Fuller circulated his report prior to the meeting and updated on his time spent on the Island Plan Strategy and the removal of the term "immediately adjacent to" the settlement boundary which has previously blurred the line for development.

#### d. IWALC

Cllr Fuller attended the meeting held on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> June 2021 and updated on the reintroduction of a voting role for IWALC on the IWC's scrutiny committee.

The Chairman provided an update on ongoing issues with the cleaning contract provided by Danfo (UK) Ltd. RESOLVED: That notice is issued to Danfo (UK) Ltd to remedy these issues at latest by the end of August 2021, to be reviewed by Full Council on 8<sup>th</sup> September 2021, with alternative provision instructed from 13<sup>th</sup> September as necessary. Agreement on signage to make pricing and closing times clearer to be deferred until September.

### b. Old School Meadow

Members updated on a number of users keen to volunteer their time at Old School Meadow with fencing and the creation of a new family friendly dog free zone should this proposal be agreed.

RESOLVED: That standing orders are suspended to enable the meeting to continue beyond two and half hours.

RESOLVED: That volunteers are welcome and encouraged to get involved by joining the Parish Council's Facilities Committee who will be considering suggestions and making decisions based on survey responses from residents about the future of the meadow in September. Whilst all help is gratefully received contributors must first notify the Clerk before carrying out any work, for insurance purposes.

The Parish Council were surprised to learn the security lock on the OSM meadow container had been recently removed.

RESOLVED: That a replacement lock is purchased ASAP with 4 keys and is refitted to protect the GPC equipment that is stored on site.
