## GPC GENERIC TERMS OF REFERENCE FOR WORKING GROUPS, PROJECT GROUPS AND PANELS

- 1. All groups have the following objectives:
  - to undertake the agreed and identified project in consultation with the parish council;
  - to work with the community, the parish council and other bodies for the benefit of the village;
  - to access funding to achieve the aims and objectives of the group;
  - to involve and consult the community and other organisations and bodies as necessary to achieve these aims and objectives.
- 2. All group members are bound by the obligations imposed by the Code of Conduct as adopted by Gurnard Parish Council.
- 3. The group will work on behalf of, and in partnership with, and will report to Gurnard Parish Council.
- 4. The group will meet as required.
- 5. The group can raise recommendations to Gurnard Parish Council for discussion and debate.
- 6. The administration of the group shall be undertaken by Gurnard Parish Clerk if available.
- 7. Gurnard Parish Council's Standing Orders will apply to the group (where relevant).
- 8. At the first meeting of the group after every Gurnard Parish Council Annual Meeting, members will reaffirm their commitment to the aims & objectives of the group and elect a chair.
- 9. Any change to the group's Terms of Reference must be approved by Gurnard Parish Council.
- 10. Notes from the meetings will be published on Gurnard Parish Council website as necessary.
