#### A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

#### HELLO THERE!

So, I am writing this lead article just days after celebrating Jesus Christ as King on Palm Sunday......and you are reading this days before we officially have a new King with Charles's coronation taking place on the 6<sup>th</sup> of this month.

2000 years or so ago they had palm leaves, a donkey and shouts of hosanna.... this month it will bunting, a golden coach and fine horses and military bands. In fact, the only similarity between the two events will be the huge crowds watching!


It has been reported that this Coronation will be not as grand as Queen Elizabeth's coronation back in 1953. Charles was the first heir to witness his mother being crowned Queen. There will be more firsts this time, when there will not only be Charles' sons watching him but also his grandchildren: two heirs in waiting watching the great events unfolding before their very eyes.


It is said the ceremony will reflect the monarch's role today and look towards the future, while being rooted in longstanding traditions and pageantry. Did King Charles ever imagine what his Coronation would be like? Has it changed over the 70 years since he watched his mother being crowned at the tender age of 4? Have you ever had an event that you were looking forward to, but in the end something changed?

That was certainly what Jesus' disciples experienced all those years ago: they were expecting Him to be a great King who would free them from the oppressive Romans but only days after his triumphant entry into Jerusalem He died on a cross. .... something they would have thought impossible.

Expectations. They are strange things. They are normally based on logic, reason, tradition, experience etc and yet so often our expectations do not materialise. My expectations when I was young was that I would get married early 20s, have a few children and do a normal job. The only one of those that has happened was the few (two) children!

I was talking to my two boys only a while ago about expectations and how they were to be ambitious but also realistic having neither picked up an instrument to date in their lives (of 13 and 11 years), they are unlikely going to





become members of the British Symphony orchestra, but they can certainly become lovers of music! One of them came back a few days later with this picture to the left and said,

'Hmmm reality is not great is it - look at this!'

Whilst I have certainly had my fair share of experiences like that picture, we must remember that there are also the opposite scenarios – really not wanting to attend an event, but then ending up having a great time; dreading a blood test (because my veins always collapse and it normally takes 4+ attempts!) but getting an awesome phlebotomist who does it first time; unexpectantly finding some of your favourite wrapped sweets at the bottom of a bag or in a pocket!!

As the saying goes there are swings and roundabouts, ups and downs! But more significantly, it isn't what <u>you do</u> to not reach your expectations, it is <u>how you deal with what happens</u>.

Hopefully King Charles will not waste time reflecting on how he could have been a better King if he was 20 years younger, but he will use his reign in the best possible way – for our country and the commonwealth, but also for his family's sake. That will be my prayer for him as he officially starts his reign.

And looking back at Jesus' disciples all those years ago, they didn't dwell on what could have been had Jesus not died on the cross. Instead, with the power of the Holy Spirit, they went across land and sea proclaiming Jesus as the Messiah.....and thanks to them, I now write to you as your local priest.

So, this month, be bold, be adventurous, set yourself some goals – most significantly be brave enough to live the life of your dreams according to your vision and purpose instead of the expectations and opinions of others.

Some of you may not be feeling so bold to dream dreams, well I say to you simply - learn to love without any conditions, help without any expectations and to live without any regrets. If you do that, you will have a very blessed life.






#### Rock Movement, Gurnard Beach.

Rocks were last month removed without authority on the Secret Beach at Gurnard. This was reported to the IW Council who took this up with the Marine Management Organisation (MMO) who issues licenses for this. I understand the MMO have since liaised with residents

#### Garden Waste.

A number of residents approached me regarding Garden Waste collections. On this, I've chased up several complaints ensuring reminders were properly sent out. In the meantime residents can either return to the waiting list or use an alternative provider, such as Onward Waste (Tel: 01983 63205)

#### Southern Water: Water Butts.

Southern Water has called door to door in eligible roads with their 'slow the flow' Water Butts. If you've not received yours, and a resident of Woodvale Road, Woodvale Close, Shore Road, Solent Lawns, Jordan Close, Gurnard Heights, Baring Road, Solent View Road, Albert Road, Worsley Road, Church Road, Hilton Road and Gurnard Pines please let me know so I can chase.

#### Unadopted Roads.

Letters have been sent to residents of many unmade roads (locally, Hilton Road)

advising householders that road conditions are to be monitored. Although some roads are worse than others, if you receive one and require support please let me know.

#### **IW Councillors Allowances.**

In line with tradition, I voted against proposals to index link with inflation IW Councillor allowances. This year, I was one of 8 Councillors to oppose this.

#### Annual Report 2022/23.

Until last year, I hand delivered Annual Reports to every home in Cowes West and Gurnard, However, this year this is not been possible due me getting older and to how long this takes me to deliver. #### Waste Bins.

Last month I received feedback regarding residents overfilling some of the bins at Gurnard Green. Please may if a bin/ bins are full either use one nearby that is not full if you cannot take rubbish home. The reason for me asking this is due to badger and foxes emptying full bins before rubbish is collected!

It has also been noted that several waste bins across Cowes and Gurnard are being used to deposit household waste. In response, where this occurs I have requested this is monitored and action taken.

#### Child Poverty.

Currently on our Island 34% of children live in poverty. Following last month's motion at Full Council to support action being undertaken to lift children from poverty, I've signed to support the national 'No child left behind' campaign. #### Second Homes.

Plans showing intent to increase by 100% Council Tax for second homes was surprisingly rejected by Full Council, if Government legislation is implemented. This, I supported as I received no resident feedback. On this, my priority has always been to support increased discounts to those on low incomes. If legislation does change, I've asked that consultation follows. In the meantime please continue to share your views.

#### E-Scooters.

For those who missed it(!) The Department for Transport in its infinite wisdom has agreed to further extend Solent E-Scooter pilots until May 2024.

#### Photo ID for voting.

From 4th May voters in local elections will be required to provide photo ID before voting. This can include passports, driving licences, disabled and 60+ concessionary passes and proof of age ID passes. If you do not hold such verification residents can apply for a free Voter Authority Certificate. For details visit: https://www.electoralcommission.org.uk/i-am-a/voter/voter-id?gclsrc=aw.ds. To note there are no Isle of Wight elections taking place until May 2025.

#### **Gurnard Parish Council Clerk**

The Parish Council has appointed a new clerk, Richard Shaul. The Council looks forward to working alongside Richard in his role. From my perspective, I have been very grateful to the support provided by Freshwater PC clerk, Heather Rowell who acted as a locum clerk since January.

#### **Cowes High Street Cycles!**

Following feedback from Cowes Town Council, our PCSO, and support from IW Council Cabinet Member, Cllr. Phil Jordan, I continue to persevere for improved signage to prevent cycles coming into conflict with pedestrians in Cowes High Street and Shooters Hill.

#### Pre-Application Planning Forums.

Following a recent training session, I learnt of Lancaster City Councils Community Engagement Forum, where the planning authority hosts meetings with Parish Councils, Ward Councillors and residents working alongside developers to shape future planning proposals. This is something I support being replicated locally, particularly where contentious applications may be heard. Meetings are minuted and hosted by Planning Officers restoring trust in the planning system.

#### Solent Forum: Historic Coastal Landfills.

The Solent Forum reported concerns on the impact of former landfills upon marine life. Chemicals such as PCB's (polychlorinated byphenyls) banned 30 years ago, are impacting adversely upon fertility. Species affected includes UK killer whales. It was reported also that chemicals in cleaning materials per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances (PFAS compounds), had widespread concentrations in seawater, which again impacted on maritime food chains.

#### Traffic Order Request: Egypt Hill

Residents have requested double yellow lines following sight lines being obstructed by parked vehicles midway on Egypt Hill. Please let me know your thoughts!

#### Fly-tipping, Crossfield Estate.

Dumped charity bags have now been removed. If you see fly-tipping, dog poo, potholes, brambles etc. and have a wizzy smart phone, report this to me via the what3words app. This enables me to direct recovery to a precise location.

#### Annual Parish Meeting (APM)



The APM, held on 26<sup>th</sup> April, had no guest speaker this year but provided an opportunity to consider feedback on the 2023/24 Precept Consultation which was on display. Parishioners ideas about what they would like considered for next year were, and will

continue to be, welcomed. Please contribute ideas you would like to be considered.

#### Beach Safety Working Party (BSWP)

The BSWP has looked particularly at bathing water quality recently. Southern Water Pathfinder Scheme should be regaining momentum over the next months - with improved communications! There is a form on the GPC website which can be completed to request a water butt, additionally, when engineers call and the householder is out, a card will be left. The SuDS Planters have been planted up and the plants will grow and fill out as the weather warms; if we have another long hot summer they will need watering! Various ways of testing sea water quality on a frequent and regular basis are also under consideration. Concerns raised about the way slipper clay has been exposed by recent works at the western end of the beach have been forwarded to the responsible bodies; responsibility does not lie with GPC but with the Marine Management Organization (MMO) and other organizations. GPC is looking for a positive outcome for all concerned.

#### Celebrating the Coronation

No suggestions from residents about how to celebrate the coronation of King Charles III have been received and so, especially as our next door neighbour, Cowes, has a big event planned on Sunday 7th May, there will be no GPC sponsored event over the coronation weekend. Remember there will be a special film and Garden Party celebration on Friday evening courtesy of Gurnard Film Society, The Portland has a Coronation party with live music on Saturday 6th, The Woodvale has some garden party events on Saturday and has their live music on Sunday 7th. There will be plenty going on.

We are also very pleased that the tree ordered for the Queen's Jubilee last year has finally been planted and is already showing signs of being very pretty. Perhaps caring more for the village environment is the best way to celebrate. We hope Gurnard in Bloom volunteers will be planting up around the village soon.

#### **Gurnard Emergency Plan**

It seems appropriate that, as a nationwide test of an emergency warning system is due to be held on 23<sup>rd</sup> April , the village Emergency Plan has come up for revision. There are a lot of names and contact details which need to be checked and updated. Please bear with us if you are contacted. Let's hope there is never a need

Ito invoke the plan but we should be prepared. If you have a trade, skill or a form of transport you think could be of practical support in an emergency and you are prepared to have your name on the village plan please contact the clerk. Contact details are given at the end of this report.

#### Hilton Road Waste Collection

A request for clarification on the expected standards of the roadway will be sent to IWC. There was discussion about how casual users of Hilton Road can be encouraged to be more considerate and to keep speeds down in order to reduce damage to the road surface. We don't have any control over rainfall!

#### Old School Meadow (OSM)

A working party in OSM in late April will aim to refine and further research some ideas about how to improve this amenity. A local resident is keen to develop a pre-school Forest School in OSM but there are concerns as a main principle of the Forest School is to teach fire safety; sessions finish gathered around a small fire, whenever it is safe and appropriate to do so. Close neighbours of OSM in particular need to be fully consulted about this idea.

Some ideas for developing OSM were expressed in the Precept Consultation and there has been correspondence received. If you have any ideas of changes you would like to see at OSM do, please, continue to contact the council through the clerk and share your thoughts about this important green space. Thank you to all those who make every effort to keep the area a lovely place to visit.
