A LETTER FROM ALL SAINTS'

HELLO THERE!

Hope you are all well as we step into the middle month of the year - JUNE!!! I am sure I am not the only one who cannot believe that we are half way through the year already!#

Are you ready for the summer? No of course not, I have been wearing jumpers and winter hats only a few weeks ago, I don't think we have had a proper spring really, do you?

Are you ready for your youngest to leave Primary school?

No of course not. I along with dozens of other parents and carers will be crying next month when our 'babies' walk out of school for the last time as independent, awesome 11 year olds!

Are you ready for your move back to the mainland? No, of course not, we are still getting our head around the fact that we are leaving the island....

Are you ready? This is something the referee asks each goalie in a football match before he blows his whistle to start the game; it is what the on-pitch umpire ask the scorers in cricket before he says play; it's what I ask every bride just before we go into the church; it's what James normally asks me each Sunday when I am reading my sermon through again just before we leave for church......So are **YOU** ready?

You lovely readers may not appreciate this question and you would certainly be entitled to say, 'ready what for?

'Because you may be ready for tomorrow's events at work, but certainly not the big celebration that your family are having at the weekend. You may be ready to sit down for a large glass of wine but not ready for the doctor's appointment tomorrow and the test results he is going to give you.

The thing is, I don't think us humans are ever really READY!
We may be organised for certain things, but I am not sure
we can be ready, because things change so much and so
quickly sometimes that even if you had Batman's utility belt,
you may not be ready for what is about to come.

So, what do we do then? How can we cope if we are not ready? Just be prepared!

Throughout my life I have always been told to be prepared – in my Scouting life, in the Royal Navy, at theological college......because if you are prepared you can pretty much deal with anything. I read a quote a while back that said, 'The best preparation for tomorrow is doing your best today', which is a nicer version of the military 6 Ps: Prior preparation prevents p... poor performance! Blunt, but true.

You may ask, 'But how can we prepare for something we don't know is going to happen?' My response would be this - Be in the best shape possible today! Going back to my wedding couples, I always tell them that they must discuss what would happen if one of them lost their job or became

ill. I have regularly told my parishioners to complete a funeral wishes leaflet and either give it to me for safe keeper or put it with all their other important documents, I even sat with my husband, parents and sister one Easter and we all completed our funeral wishes around the table. I always tell my boys not to put off until tomorrow things that can be completed today, especially if its homework!!!!

Am I the perfectly prepared person? No, I am human, and I am very good at giving sound advice but do not always act upon it myself. However, I know I only have myself to blame when it does all go wrong, and I am completely disorganised and looking a fool!

The bible mentions being prepared numerous times, both in the Old and New Testament and Jesus himself gave many a teaching on the subject. My favourite quote is from Luke's Gospel Chapter 21, verse 36 "Pray constantly that you will have the strength and wits to make it through everything that's coming and end up on your feet before the Son of Man."





Unmade Roads.

I continue to receive enquiries on the potential disruption to waste collection from unmade roads. In Broadfields Avenue residents have banded together to infill potholes. In Hilton Road I am happy to support residents given traffic volumes and the road's gradient which causes issues.

Noise Complaints.

I have recently received complaints regarding noise nuisance. This ensures officers can fully understand the harm created. To assist officers please keep a log of incidents and when (and where) they occur.

Southern Water: Water Butts.

Southern Water are calling door to door in eligible roads with their 'slow the flow' Water Butts. If you've not received yours, and a resident of Woodvale Road, Woodvale Close, Shore Road, Solent Lawns, Jordan Close, Gurnard Heights, Baring Road, Solent View Road, Albert Road, Worsley Road, Church Road, Hilton Road and

Gurnard Pines please provide your address, so I can chase.

English Coastal Path.

Dialogue continues between landowners and Natural England on the East Cowes-Wootton section of the path.

Chapters 8 and 9 (Thorness-Cowes) are due to open, following the Green light by the Secretary of State. Grateful thanks to landowners, particularly Miles Downer for accelerating opening the section of the path between Gurnard Luck and Sticelett Farm.

Waste Bins.

At Gurnard Green, if a bin is full please use one nearby, if you cannot take rubbish home. The reason for asking this is due to badger and foxes emptying full bins after dark! Several waste bins across Cowes and Gurnard are being used to dispose of household waste. On this, the position is being monitored, and I'm advised action will be taken.

In the meantime three damaged bins on Egypt Esplanade are scheduled to be replaced.

Jet Ski (Personal Watercraft): New Legislation.

New legislation has been introduced to prevent dangerous misuse of watercraft such as jet skis. New Powers mean that:

Anyone riding a jet ski recklessly or causing harm to others could now face up to years in prison and an unlimited fine.

Maritime and Coastguard Agency to be granted more powers to prosecute. In addition the Maritime Police Unit also has powers under local the local bye-law.

£2 Single Fares Extended.

Introduced earlier this year, the Government funded scheme to allow a £2 single bus fare on most bus routes has been extended to 30th June 2023.

Northwood Recreation Ground.

Ward Councillor, John Nicholson and I have contacted the IW Council regarding the deteriorating condition of the path leading to the Cricket Club. On this, we're told re-patching will take place 'imminently'. Also of concern is the overfilled dog bins. It has been noted that individuals have been seen arriving by car and disposing of large volumes of poo. This matter is being monitored.

Highways Issues.

- I continue to persevere with officers on flooding issues associated with The Dottens.
- A request has been made to increase traffic restrictions in Egypt Hill. I
 understand officers have visited the site to assess the health and safety
 merits of any scheme. Following my previous report, I've received feedback
 opposing this. Should this proceed, this will be subject to wider
 consultation.
- A further request has been made to resurface Worsley Road, this follows an incident involving a cyclist and a pot hole. In the short term action was taken to infill the hole.
- I was asked to intervene following road closures at Rolls Hill and Porchfield.
 Once it was made clear that residents could not access the area, Island Roads intervened to reopened the road.

Short Term Holiday Let Consultation.

Government are consulting on use of short term holiday lets. The issue of Air B&B and similar lets have had an impact locally since the COVID lockdown. This continues until 7th June. Also this month:

- If you have a disability and struggle to specify times to visit Lynnbottom or Afton Tips, call Waste Services on 01983 823777 who are happy to work with you to find a solution to dispose of waste.
- I received further confirmation that with a positive response from the landowner, the English Coastal Path will follow the dog leg (as residents requested) through Spencer's Copse.
- A very big thank you to those who attended (with me for once!) the Village Tidy Up. Thank you also to the lovely Gary and Debbie from Plaza who gave a free Mr Whippy and Flake to volunteers!
- With my neighbouring IW Councillor, I have been asked to look into the issue of parked trailers in and around Place Road. Because there are no TRO's, we are seeking further options...
- I am awaiting a formal response from the IW Council regarding a selfimposed village Green designation for sections of the Gurnard Green not already covered. I am hopeful this is pending!



Gurnard Parish Council Report May 2023 Annual Meeting of the Council (ACM)

The ACM was held on May 10th. This is the meeting where councillors decide on which councillor will hold the Chair for the following year and the membership of various committees and Parish Council working groups. Paul Fuller was elected Chair for another year. Let's hope that this will be an easier year for him as our new clerk, Richard

Shaul, continues to grow into the big role he has taken on.

Beach Safety Working Party (BSWP)

The BSWP will continue as a Working Party and Cllr Mark Franklin will remain as Chair. Mark has done a great job setting up a form on the GPC website allowing residents in eligible streets to apply for water butts. We can monitor these applications and know that more water butts have been fitted; we are looking forward to hearing about the difference this may have made to water quality on Gurnard beach when we next meet with Southern Water.

Celebrating the Coronation

We hope parishioners were able to celebrate the Coronation in their own ways. Certainly more than 50 people enjoyed some scrumptious savouries 'light bites' and a fantastic cake before settling in to watch the charming film, Passport to Pimlico, set up by Gurnard Film Society.

As the environment has long been a passion of King Charles III, improving our village environment seemed a fitting way to celebrate too. Some of you may have noticed that work has started on both Worsley Road borders and planters. Huge thanks to village residents who have put in so much effort here, Sue and Mathilde in particular, but also residents who have promised donations of plants or help with labour. Jennie Lewis and Cllr Penny Acton look forward to re-joining the RHS Communities in Bloom scheme soon and hope this will be the beginning of a Village Environment group.

Gurnard Emergency Plan and Flood Plan

There is a lot of work needed on these plans. We hope that parishioners might be prepared to look at the plans on-line (they are both on the GPC website) and think about ways they may be able to support other villagers in times of emergency. A meeting to look at these plans will probably be held early in the Autumn.

Old School Meadow (OSM)

It was with regret on both sides, councillors and Forest School organizers, that the idea of developing a Forest School (FS) at OSM has been given up. The clash between the council's No Fires policy and the needs of the FS to have a fire at part

of their ethos could not be reconciled. However, if there are any landowners in the parish who have some space, ideally with both trees and access to a beach and some minimal parking facilities, then the FS organizer is still very keen to provide this amenity in the Gurnard, Cowes, Northwood area. Please contact the clerk if you want to find out more and to be put in touch with the FS organizer.

Although there will be no formal Forest School, councillors recognise that new ideas are needed in OSM and that refurbishment of facilities is required; the mud kitchen in particular is looking very dilapidated and the furniture there needs improvement. It would be good to have some more 'natural' play opportunities in the space and to encourage more diverse use. It should not be seen just as a dog walking spot.
